Data processing legitimation

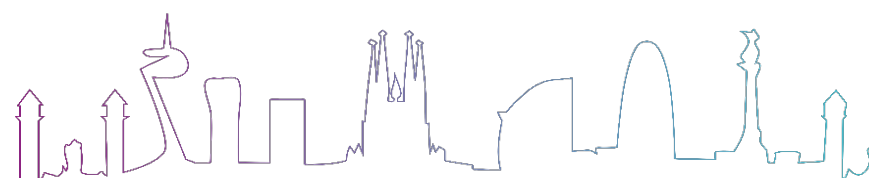

Receiver of the data

International data transfer

Data preservation -

The data provided will be kept:

- The data provided to receive newsletters and informative communications will be kept until the interested party cancels their data or, failing that, until December 31, 2023, the date on which all data provided will be destroyed due to the end of the actions related to the congress.

Rights of the interested parties

The owner of the personal data has the right to:
